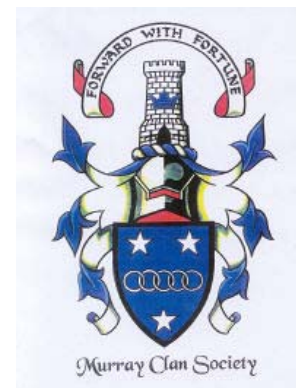

## Membership

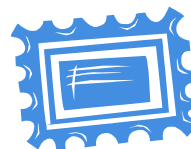


The Murray Clan Society of North America (the Society) was founded in 1969. It is a non-profit organization incorporated in the State of Delaware.

### Purposes

## Membership

Regular membership in the Society is open to persons 18 years of age or older who present documentation that establishes a relationship with the Murray Clan, or those bearing the names of a traditional Sept or allied family such as **Balneaves, Dinsmore, Dunsmore, Fleming, Moray, Murrie, Neaves, Piper, Pyper, Smail, Smale, Small, Smeal** and **Spaulding**. Those not meeting these criteria may apply for Associate membership.

<sup>i</sup> Any person qualifying and applying for Regular membership and currently paying annual dues, as established by the Council of the Society. Regular Society members shall be eligible to vote, hold elected office or appointed position, and may serve in any appointed position.

<sup>ii</sup> Any person not qualifying for Regular membership, but who is willing to actively uphold the principles of the Society Constitution, shall be eligible for associate membership in the Clan Murray Society. Each such associate member shall be eligible to vote and to serve in any appointed position, but may not hold an elected office.

<sup>iii</sup> Any Regular member who is at least 75 years of age and been an active member of the Society for a minimum of 10 years may petition the Council for Emeritus status. Emeritus members are exempt from the requirement to pay annual dues, but retain all rights and privileges of Regular membership.
